

a home that is out of date, ugly, dark, chaotic or designed specifically for the previous owner. I may not be allowed to renovate the apartment I rent, but I can live vicariously. I like how the teams strip away the layers and give the home new life. Sometimes they




find hidden issues and dangers that need to be addressed as layer by layer they transform the space into something fresh and new.

You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you. Romans 12:1-2.





#### October Book & Puzzle Sale


The Adult 2 Sunday School class is sponsoring a Book/Puzzle Sale to raise money for Missions. During
